## Important Information about the REAL ID

If you are interested in obtaining an optional REAL ID from PennDOT before October 2020, then you will need to verify your identity using the following documents per federal regulations.

You need to bring the following to any DMV:

- **Proof of Identity** - an original or certified copy of a birth certificate with a raised seal issued by authorized government or valid passport.
- **Social Security Card.**
- **Two proofs of your current address** such as your current license or ID or valid PA vehicle registration.
- **Proof of all legal name changes** - if applicable, such as a court-issued marriage certificate or court issued by your county's family county.
